



Thank you for your prayers! I know that God is answering them. So many exciting things have happened this fall; I can't wait to share them with you. We have had 7 new groups officially start and 2 groups reactivate. Here are some details of what God is doing in a few areas across the country:

UCLA – Several years ago a nurse at the medical center wanted to start a NCF group for nurses and students, but the obstacles of varied schedules was too much to overcome. Then, this summer, I was contacted separately by a former student leader from NJ who is now a new nurse at UCLA and a grad student at UCLA. They collaborated and held their first meeting this fall. 22 students came. That is an incredible response!

Florida State U – This chapter had dwindled to 2 students who graduated, leaving a faculty advisor wondering how to attract new students. God moved in the heart of a student named Bethany, beginning at the last Urbana when she learned about NCF at our exhibit. She has revitalized the group, where there are 8 committed students, 3 faculty involved, up to 30 students coming to events and 70+ on their email list. God is at work!



University of Pennsylvania – Two students had inquired a year or so ago about how to start a group, but nothing happened. Recently a senior died after completing a half marathon. He was a strong Christian, who made an impact on all around him. As a result of his death, students have decided to come together to form a NCF chapter. Pray for Linda as she has sent out invitations and is organizing those who are interested. Please pray for these students as they grieve and desire to reach out to those who are seeking.

UW-Madison – When the student leaders graduated and the faculty advisor left, leaving a lone junior, we didn't know if there would be a chapter this year. Praise God for Brandon, who has come in and pulled together a leadership team of 5 students. They plan to reactivate the chapter this coming semester. Pray that they will receive approval, find an advisor and a good time to meet.

Praise for new NCF Campus Volunteers. We are so glad to have Miriam Robinson join us to work part time at UNC-Greensboro, Amanda Green is a grad student working to start a group at UMass in Boston, and Irielle Gant is working with students at LSU and nurses in New Orleans. Please pray for them as they balance work, family and ministry roles.

Please join me in prayer for:

- Several groups plan to start in January: U of AR – Fayetteville, California Baptist University, LA County College of Nursing, Western Illinois University, Kentucky Christian University, and Stephen F. Austin University, Cox Health Systems
- A student chapter that wants to start at Mercer Community College in NJ, but the faculty advisor has run into obstacles with getting approval from another College who is "loaning" her to Mercer. Ask God to work in the minds and hearts of campus administrators so they will give approval for NCF chapters to organize on their campuses.
- There is potential for NCF ministry at 3 schools in the Duluth, MN area, but we don't have any nurse or faculty contacts there. Please pray that God would provide someone with a heart for nursing students to be involved with IV staff there.
